MIKISEW CITIZENSHIP COMMITTEE

Mikisew Cree First Nation (MCFN) is seeking qualified applicants to serve on the Citizenship Committee.

This Committee plays a vital role in guiding the Nation's transition from a membership-based system to a sovereignty-driven Citizenship Law grounded in Treaty, ancestral lineage, and inherent rights.

About the Citizenship Committee

The Committee is responsible for:

- Reviewing Citizenship applications using the MCFN Citizenship Law and Operating Procedures
- Ensuring decisions honour Mikisew Cree cultural teachings, Treaty obligations, and historical family lineages
- Providing fair, consistent, and transparent recommendations to Chief & Council
- Upholding confidentiality and acting with integrity at all times

Eligibility Criteria - Must be registered member of Mikisew Cree First Nation

Applicants must demonstrate:

- Strong knowledge of the historical roots of Mikisew Cree family lineages (familiarity with traditional kinship, major families, and ancestral connections is required)
- Long-standing connection to the Mikisew Cree First Nation
- Understanding of MCFN history, Treaty 8, and Indigenous governance
- Ability to maintain confidentiality and follow the Oath of Confidentiality
- Commitment to unbiased, culturally grounded decision-making
- Ability to attend meetings, review documentation, and participate respectfully in consensus-building
